



## Information on Your Prescription Drug Benefit

***Starting this year, your prescription drug benefit is provided by your medical plan. Here are some important things to know about getting your prescription drugs:***

**1** Destroy your Express Scripts ID card. You will no longer be able to use it when you get prescription drugs.

**2** When you go to a pharmacy, show the pharmacists your medical plan's ID card. This is how the pharmacy will know how to charge you.

**3** Health Net and Blue Shield both contract with Express Scripts to provide mail order drugs to their plan participants. If you are enrolled in either of these plans ***and have used Express Scripts in the past***, you will ***need to re-register*** with Express Scripts. You can either do this online or by mail, but you cannot use your previous Express Scripts profile.
